• Participants may camp for free at a Rock Harbor group site, or stay in the Rock Harbor Lodge or housekeeping units at their own expense. Total cost for the workshop is US \$675 per person if registered by March 5, 2012. After this date the cost is \$699. (\$25 discount for IRKPA members; see <http://irkpa.org/> for information on becoming a member). A \$200 deposit is required. The balance is due by April 17, 2012. Fee covers instruction, camping, meals on the island, and transportation to and from Houghton, Michigan on the Ranger III. A cancellation fee of \$75 will be charged for cancellations after May 1, 2012. There will be no refund for cancellations made after June 1, 2012. After registering, a letter from the instructor will be sent with equipment and workshop thoughts. If wishing to find someone to share a room at housekeeping, contact Kristine. Spouses can participate in all but the workshop for a lower price.

• Some of the topics to be covered are:

- * What all the dials and buttons mean and do on the camera
- * How to read and understand your histogram and why
- * The effects of shutter speeds and f/stops and depth of field
- * Obtaining the proper exposure
- * Creating stronger images through better composition
- * Seeing the light
- * Improving your images in a computer editing program
- * Critiques of your images
- * Digital workflow
